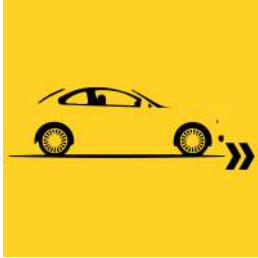

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

AFTER PAVING COMPLETION



Enter and exit your driveway in a straight motion.



Avoid turning your steering wheel while vehicle is not in motion or in an isolated area.



Avoid pointed objects on the driveway such as, pointed-heels, bicycle kick-stands, or hard tired equipment such as: roller blades, lawn mowers, or trailers until after 48 hours.



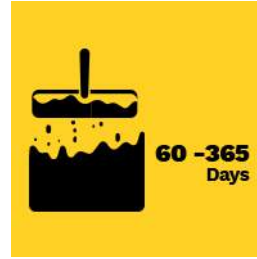
Avoid leaving vehicles parked for extended periods of time on your driveway.



Avoid driving over edges of driveway.



In times of drought, allow water to run on your driveway to avoid cracking from excessive dryness.



60 -365
Days

Seal-coat your driveway after a minimum of a 60 day period to a year after its completion to allow driveway curing time.



2 YEARS
in a row

Seal-coat your driveway two years in-a-row after it is newly paved and then every-other-year there after.

SEAL COATING

COAL-TAR OR ASPHALT EMULSION APPLIED OVER ASPHALT SURFACES TO PROTECT FROM DAILY DESTRUCTIVE FORCES.

Protects against natural elements such as sunlight, snow, ice and salt.

Allows for easier sweeping, cleaning and maintenance of asphalt.

2.



Protects from the deteriorating effects of oil, gas, and hazardous chemicals.

Gives asphalt a new black finish enhancing the look of any property.

Increase water runoff by filling in the asphalt pores and creating a smooth surface.

Will increase the life of existing asphalt and save money by reducing repair costs.
